

# City Of Osseo Snow and Ice Control



The City of Osseo maintains 19 miles of streets with 3 single axle plow trucks and 1 wheel loader.

Full snow removal will be initiated if the city receives a total accumulation of 2" or greater of snow on the street. A normal snow event of 6" or less should take the Public Works Crew approximately 6-8 hours to clear all the roads in the city. A major snow event greater than 6" will take the crews longer to clear.

Crews will maintain high priority routes first with salt/sand mix or salt as required during emergency conditions i.e., freezing rain, sleet or ice, with side streets to follow.



## What can You Do?

1. Minimize travel.
2. Park your car off the street. **Sec. 10-1-27**
3. **Wait!!!** to shovel snow until the crews finished plowing your street. This takes 2 to 3 passes on each side of the street to clear it.
4. **Sidewalks must be cleared of snow and ice within 24 hours following a snowfall or icy weather. Report uncleared sidewalks to City Hall at 715-597-2207. Sec. 6-2-7 (a)**
5. If you have a hydrant around your property, please clear the snow around it.
6. Be aware of snow pile placement to not create a traffic hazard or create issues for your neighbors. **You cannot deposit snow in the street. Sec. 6-2-7 (b) (2)**
7. Be patient, allow extra travel time, and drive with caution.
